Bio

Eliza Ivanova is an animator at Pixar Animation Studios, San Francisco, California. So far she has worked on three feature films at Pixar - Cars 2, Brave, and Monsters University, which premieres in the summer of 2013.

Eliza started her professional career at Pixar back in 2010 after graduating from the California Institute of the Arts (Calarts) with a BFA degree in traditional character animation. At Calarts, she won the highest award for best short film during her third year of college. Eliza moved to the US in 2006 to pursue her education and career in animation, as well as film, in Los Angeles, California. In Bulgaria, she graduated from the American College of Sofia, and in the meantime she took private art lessons in the studio of Garo Muradyan, with whom she had been learning and practicing fine art since the age of 12.

Eliza has long background in fine arts and aims to blend her painting skills with motion picture. While at Calarts, she completed four student animated short films, all of which were selected in film festivals in the US and around the world. 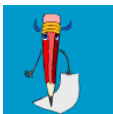

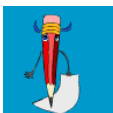
